

What is Olio? (olioapp.com)

Olio is a sharing app for local communities, making it easy to give away the things you don't need to someone else who would value them. It can be downloaded onto phones.

Olio volunteers collect food from supermarkets / cafes that would throw food out at the end of the day due to expiry dates etc, The food is listed on the app, customers can then select which foods they want, and where to collect it from for *free*.

Customers register for free and the app will then show the nearest volunteers with the food they have.
